


What if I'm not going to Hurst Jr. High?

- They day ends at 3:35.








Lockers, Buses, Fees



- Red Raider Athletics
- State law REQUIRES a physical for ALL students in athletics.
- Boys MUST play football in order to enroll in athletics for fall semester.
- Boy sports include: football, basketball, cross-country and track.
- Girls sports include: volleyball, basketball, cross-country, track and soccer--Girls must play a sport to be in Athletics.
- For students not playing football, there will be tryouts to make the other sports teams, so you will need to select PE.
- All athletes are required to purchase and wear HJH athletic attire.
- No jewelry is allowed in athletics.











Competitive Gymnastics Team

- Males and females can try out for the competitive gymnastics team instead of Athletics or PE.

7th Grade Required Courses & Electives: Every student takes 7 classes per day.

- 1. English

- 6. Elective OR Reading (Reading Course is intended for the student who needs continued reinforcement of fundamental reading skills. Exemption from this course is based on district criteria.)
- 7. Elective OR STAAR Math (STAAR Math Course is intended for the student who needs continued reinforcement of fundamental math skills. Exemption from this course is based on district criteria.)



Electives:



Electives are offered on each campus based on the student requests and of the availability of the staff.

Although efforts are made to provide students with their favorite elective choice, scheduling conflicts may make that impossible. Electives are requests and **NOT** guaranteed.

Consequently, students are asked to rank electives 1, 2, 3, 4 etc., according to preference. Use the descriptions in this presentation and the course booklet to choose your electives.




